

## TDR Projects Limited: Case Study

TDR Projects Limited was engaged to undertake full emergency reroofing works on this 19<sup>th</sup> century Grade 2 listed building on behalf of J Mills developments **following storm damage to the gate house.**

### Rear Elevation



The project involved the removal of the existing roof covering and the installation of over 7,000 Old English Red 10x6 tiles, **carefully maintaining the decorative patterns to preserve the gatehouse's heritage.** The south elevation gable verge was finished using the Winchester cut technique, with over 30 collared ridge tiles, 20 linear metres of mortar gable verges, and 18 linear metres of valley tiles installed. Additional work included the installation of a new rainwater system with Pro-Style gutters, 6 metres of step flashings to the chimney, and a turret featuring lead over rolled hip timbers.
