TDR Projects Limited was engaged to undertake roofing works at **Kingsley Old Vicarage**, a prestigious domestic project requiring high-quality craftsmanship and precise execution. The project involved the supply and install to complete an extensive tiled roof installation while maintaining the historical and aesthetic integrity of the property.

The project included the installation of **over 12,000 Staffordshire Blue 10x6 tiles**, over 80 collared ridge tiles, 32 linear metres of mortar gable verges, and 21 linear metres of secret valleys (closed cut). Additional work involved a tiled dormer cheek with 17m lead aprons and 12m step flashings, along with a turret featuring lead over rolled hip timbers.
